WEATHER

Parts of the visit will take place outside. Please ensure that children all come dressed with appropriate footwear and clothing.

TRANSPORT

There is a car park on site which provides free parking.

There is a designated Coach Park on site

We can accommodate several minibuses

ACCESSIBILITY

The site is accessible to all users and we have a wheel chair which can be loaned out.

Only two exhibits, due to the nature of their original historical design cannot be accessed by a wheelchair user; The Pillbox and Anderson Shelter.

QUANTITIES

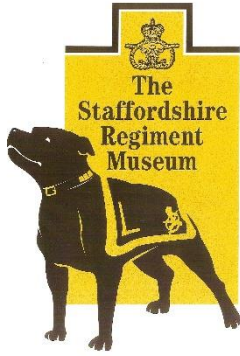
The Museum can facilitate up to a maximum of 60 pupils at one time. Larger groups can be spread over several days.

Pupils will be split into groups of 10-15 and each group will require a member of staff or helper to accompany them.

COSTINGS

Pupils will be charge £6 per head. This fee includes VAT.

Teachers and helpers are free of charge.



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TIMINGS

Our education team are made up of volunteers and the normal teaching hours are 10am until 12.30pm.
