The Museum is a registered charity and donations fund the conservation and maintenance of its Archive & Library. The work is done by our research team, who are unpaid volunteers.

For an initial enquiry for us to do up to an hour's research, we ask for a donation of £20. Should it require extended research, we will contact you before further work is done to agree a price.

If you wish to do your own research by using our Archive & Library material, contact us with your requirements and expected length of visit and to agree a donation. Please note the Archive & Library closes for a short time around 1300 hours.

We ask you pay in advance by cheque, payable to "Staffordshire Regiment Museum"

We hope you will make your payment through Gift Aid.

Copyright and Copies of Documents, Books and Images

We do not normally permit photocopies of books or of original documents and images as many items are old and fragile. We will consider making copies and if permissible we will inform you. You must complete, sign and return a **Copyright Declaration Form** before we can process your request.

A photocopy, printout or digital image of a page or a document is **50p**

A digital image of a photograph with at least 300 dpi is £10 and will be emailed to you.

If you do not have email, then a hard copy in A5 or A4 will be made and posted to you. You will be asked to pay in advance the costs to produce the copies with any p&p at the standard UK rates applicable at the time.
