

Practical Information and FAQ's

WEATHER

Parts of the visit will take place outside. Please ensure that children all come dressed in appropriate footwear and clothing.

TRANSPORT

There is a car park on site which provides free parking. There is a designated Coach Park on site and the Museum can accommodate up to several minibuses.

ACCESSIBILITY

The site is accessible to all users, and we have a wheelchair which can be loaned out. Only two exhibits, due to the nature of their original historical design cannot be accessed by a wheelchair user: The Pillbox and Anderson Shelter.

GROUP SIZES

The Museum can facilitate up to a maximum of 30 pupils at one time. Larger groups can be accommodated, please contact the Museum to discuss this. Learners will normally be split into groups of 10-15 and each group will require a member of your team to accompany them.

COST

Pupils will be charge £7, plus VAT per learner. Teachers, Carers, Facilitators etc. accompanying the Learners are free of charge.

TIMINGS

Our Learning sessions normally take place from 1000 to 1230, however we are happy to accommodate variations in timings, so please contact us to discuss.
